Your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected by the Federal Department of Education for review in a process called "Verification." In this process, the Office of Student Financial Services will compare information from your FAFSA with this worksheet and other required documents. The Verification must be finalized prior to the distribution of federal aid. If inconsistencies are found between your FAFSA, verification worksheet, and other documentation, the Office of Student Financial Services may electronically amend the necessary changes.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Complete this section if you and/or your parents <u>filed or will file</u> a 2023 IRS Federal Income Tax Return(s). As part of the federal student aid eligibility, you and your parents will be required to consent and approve sharing and importing income and tax information from the IRS to the FAFSA form, even if the attempt to obtain or use such data is ineffective. In other words, if your parents filed separate 2023 IRS Federal Income Tax Returns, both must provide consent and approval to share and import income and tax information from the IRS. In most cases, no further documentation is needed to verify 2023 income information that was transferred into the student's FAFSA using income and tax information directly from the IRS.

 - <u>Automated Telephone Request</u>—1-800-908-9946. Transcript is generally received within 10 business days from the IRS's receipt of the telephone request.
 - Paper Request Form—IRS Form 4506T-EZ or IRS Form 4506-T. The transcript is generally received within 10 business days.
- 3. You and at least one parent must sign this worksheet.
- 4. Submit the completed and signed Verification Worksheet with the required documentation to the Office of Student Financial Services.
